9.2 Bracknell Forest Borough Council Correspondence

Bracknell Forest Council is promoting a new Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) which will contain a waiting restriction scheme on Turnpike Road, Binfield.

It is proposed to install 'No Waiting At Any Time' restrictions approximately 100m along Turnpike Ride from its junction with Beehive Road. The restrictions have been proposed after concerns were raised about the possibility of overspill parking on Turnpike Road from visitors to the new elderly peoples care home.
