Byelaws for Dogs on Leads for Pleasure Grounds and Open Spaces

Made	9 January 1995
Confirmed	25 January 1995
Date of Operation	1 March 1995

DOGS ON LEADS

Byelaws made by the Council of the Parish of Binfield under Section 164 of the Public Health Act 1875 with respect to pleasure grounds.

EXTENT

- 1. (1) These byelaws apply to Foxley Fields, Binfield and hereafter referred to as "the ground".
 - (2) These byelaws do not apply to any roads within the ground for the time being designated under section 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1988
 - (3) These byelaws do not apply in respect of any dogs to which section 1 of the Dangerous Dogs Act 1991 applies.
 - (4) Notice of the effect of these byelaws shall be given by signs placed in conspicuous positions in or near the ground.

INTERPRETATION

- 2. (1) In these byelaws:
 - 'the Council' means the Parish of Binfield
 - (2) For the purpose of these byelaws the keeper of the dog shall be deemed in charge thereof, unless at the time when the dog was present in the ground without being held on a lead it had been placed in or taken into the charge of some other person.
 - (3) In paragraph (2) above, "the keeper" shall include the owner of the dog or any person who habitually has it in his possession.

DOGS ON LEADS

3. No person in charge of a dog shall, without reasonable excuse, permit the dog to enter or remain in the ground unless the dog is held on a lead and is restrained from behaviour giving reasonable ground for annoyance.

REMOVAL OF OFFENDERS

4. Any person offending against byelaw 3 may be removed from the ground by an officer of the Council or any constable.

PENALTY

5. Any person offending against byelaw 3 shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale.
